WHAT WE BELIEVE

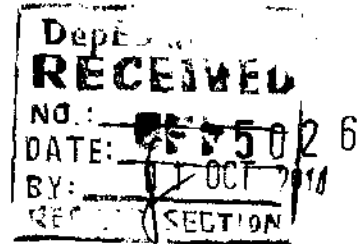
