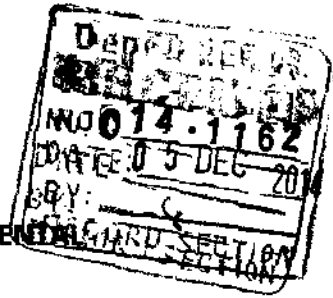

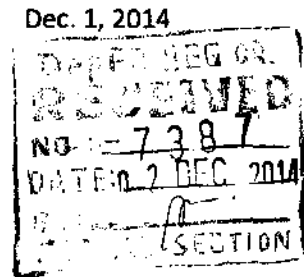

Almost two years ago, in a concerted effort to provide child-sensitive and more effective response to cases of child abuse, the Gender Watch Against Violence and Exploitation was selected by Consuelo Foundation to be its implementing partner for the Child Abuse Prevention and Intervention Network (CAPIN) program that aims to strengthen the network of support and service-providers for children in abusive and vulnerable circumstances. 
