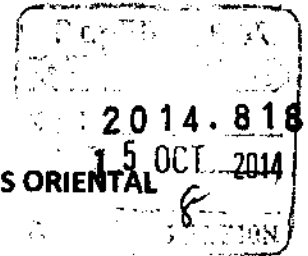

SUBJECT: Coalition for Better Education and One Meralco Foundation Teachers' Camp

DATE: October 13, 2014

During a meeting held last October 8, 2014 among One Meralco Foundation (OMF) and the Coalition for Better Education (CBE) with Sec. Br. Armin A. Lustrero FSC and the undersigned, programs on energy education for DepEd Schools were extensively discussed. One of these is the creation of learning resource materials in the form of Science flashcards that will focus mainly on energy and related topics.

Realizing also the need to distribute learning materials for displaced students in the Albay area due to the impending Mayon Volcano eruption, the Secretary suggested to fast track the creation and distribution of these flashcards as enhancement learning materials for 78 affected schools in the above mentioned area.

On this note, we are requesting the attendance of teachers to participate in a Teachers' Camp organized by OMF with the CBE solely for this purpose. The program is designed specifically as a workshop where participants will be coached to develop and design learning/digital resource materials such as flashcards and CAIs for use first in DepEd schools in Albay. The cards will be distributed nationwide on a later date. These teachers have been trained previously by the CBE on PBL Approaches and ICT Integration, Content Development, Authentic Assessment and Peer and Lead Coaching. They carry with them vast experience on various teaching pedagogies using 21st Century Learning Approaches.

The Teachers' Camp will be held at the Quest Hotel, Cebu City on October 20 to October 25, 2014 (Oct. 19 and 26 – travel dates). We kindly request you to de-load these teachers from INSET Training participation and other school-related activities during this period to attend this program.

RT Plane/boat/bus Fare, board and lodging are free of charge. However, we request that other land travel expenses such as hotel-port-hotel transfers and terminal fees of the participant/s be charged against the school's MOOE. We are therefore requesting your good

office to kindly issue the respective travel order to the teacher participant/s. Attached is list of Teachers Camp Participants for your reference.

Confirmation:

Please confirm your attendance by sending a text to CBE Secretariat thru **0915-2427890 / 0922-4908485** on or before October 16, 2014.

Travel Itinerary:

The training is **FREE OF CHARGE**, including bus/boat/plane expenses. Other local land travel expenses and terminal fees however, shall be charged to pax account.

Plane Travel: CBE will take care of your plane tickets. Your e-tickets will be emailed to you anytime next week.

Boat Travel: Those who will be taking the boat are requested to buy their tickets on a cost-reimbursement basis. Kindly submit a copy of your ticket as proof of purchase. It is encouraged that you buy round-trip ticket.

Bus Travel: please submit a copy of your ticket as proof of purchase. You will also be given a bus travel allowance for your return trip.

Travel Order:

Please check/follow-up your principal and SDS for the issuance of your TOs.

Accommodations:

Hotel accommodation and full board meals are provided. Participants will be billeted at Crown Regency Hotel, Osmena Boulevard, Cebu City on October 19, 2014. However, the live-in training starts on October 20, 2014 and will end on October 25, 2014. Check-out will be on October 26, 2014 before 12:00 noon. Breakfast is served from October 20 – 26, 2014.

Activity Schedule:

Sessions start at exactly 9:00 a.m. No breaks for a.m. session. It is essential that the participant take breakfast or a full meal before the sessions start in the morning.
